Note on Meals

Breakfast is typically provided at most hotels, but it is not guaranteed in every location in Belize or Guatemala. If breakfast is not available, there are excellent local cafés and bakeries nearby. Your guide and host will offer daily recommendations.

Itinerary

Day 1 – Arrival in Belize City

Welcome to Belize! Arrive at any time and transfer independently to our starting hotel. Get settled, meet your fellow travelers, and join your local guide for our evening orientation between **6:00–7:00 PM**, followed by our **Welcome Dinner (included)** hosted by Pride Adventures.

 Overnight: Golden Bay Hotel (or similar), Belize City

Day 2 – Journey to Flores, Guatemala

We'll cross the border into Guatemala and travel to the scenic lakeside town of Flores. Spend your afternoon exploring its colorful colonial streets or relaxing with sunset views by the water. Please have your passport and cash ready for border fees when crossing into Guatemala.

Day 3 – Explore the Ruins of Tikal

Today we take a guided journey through the ancient jungle city of Tikal, one of the most impressive Maya archaeological sites in the world. Keep an eye out for howler monkeys, toucans, and towering temples. Tikal was once one of the most powerful Maya cities, dating back to 400 BCE, and is now recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

 Overnight: Hotel Petén (or similar), Flores

Day 4 – Cross Back to Belize & Head to San Ignacio

We'll return to Belize and head to the lively town of San Ignacio. Spend the afternoon at your leisure or choose from optional excursions like visiting nearby Maya ruins such as Xunantunich or joining a horseback ride through the jungle.

 Overnight: The Log Cab-Inn (or similar), San Ignacio

Day 5 – Optional Caves, Ruins & Adventure

Choose your own adventure today! Excursions may include the Actun Tunichil Muknal (ATM) Cave, Barton Creek Cave canoeing, Caracol ruins, or cave tubing. These optional activities can be booked directly with your guide once in Belize, and payment is made locally.

 Overnight: The Log Cab-Inn (or similar), San Ignacio

 Included meals: None

Day 6 – Travel to Caye Caulker

The journey from San Ignacio to Caye Caulker takes most of the day, including a road transfer and water taxi via Belize City. Upon arrival, embrace the island's "Go Slow" lifestyle and join our included **Bike with Purpose** tour—an inspiring island ride that supports local youth through community tourism.

 Overnight: Hotel Tropical Paradise (or similar), Caye Caulker

 Included meals: None

Day 7 – Snorkeling & Sunset Sailing

Enjoy a full day in paradise. Optional activities include snorkeling the Hol Chan Marine Reserve or sea kayaking along the coast. In the evening, join the group for our **included Sunset Sailing Excursion**, featuring fresh ceviche, rum punch, and island vibes.

 Overnight: Hotel Tropical Paradise (or similar), Caye Caulker

Day 8 – Relax or Explore

Enjoy your final full day in Caye Caulker with time to swim, shop, or take part in optional excursions like fishing or spa treatments. In the evening, we'll gather for a **Farewell Dinner (included)** hosted by Pride Adventures.

Day 9 – Departure from Caye Caulker

Depart at any time. Ferries back to Belize City run frequently; please ensure your flight departs after 11:30 AM to allow time to reach the airport. A ferry (about 1 hour) and taxi (about 30 minutes) are required to reach Belize City Airport. Tickets can be purchased locally.
